Waringarri Aboriginal Arts was established in the early 1980s by senior cultural leaders of the East Kimberley as a place for art and culture while also supporting economic aspirations for artists and their community.

Situated in the heart of Miriwoong Country, in Kununurra, the East Kimberley, the art centre is owned and operated by the Miriwoong community. It is the first Indigenous owned art centre established in Western Australia and one of the oldest continuously operating art centres in Australia.

Waringarri Arts specialises in ochre paintings, artefacts, sculptures, limited edition prints, engraved boab nuts, ceramics and textiles.

- Discover Dreamtime stories and understand contemporary Aboriginal histories.
- Experience a Mantha (traditional welcome).
- Enjoy a taste of delicious damper and bush foods.
- Take home more than a memory with a visit to Waringarri Art Gallery.

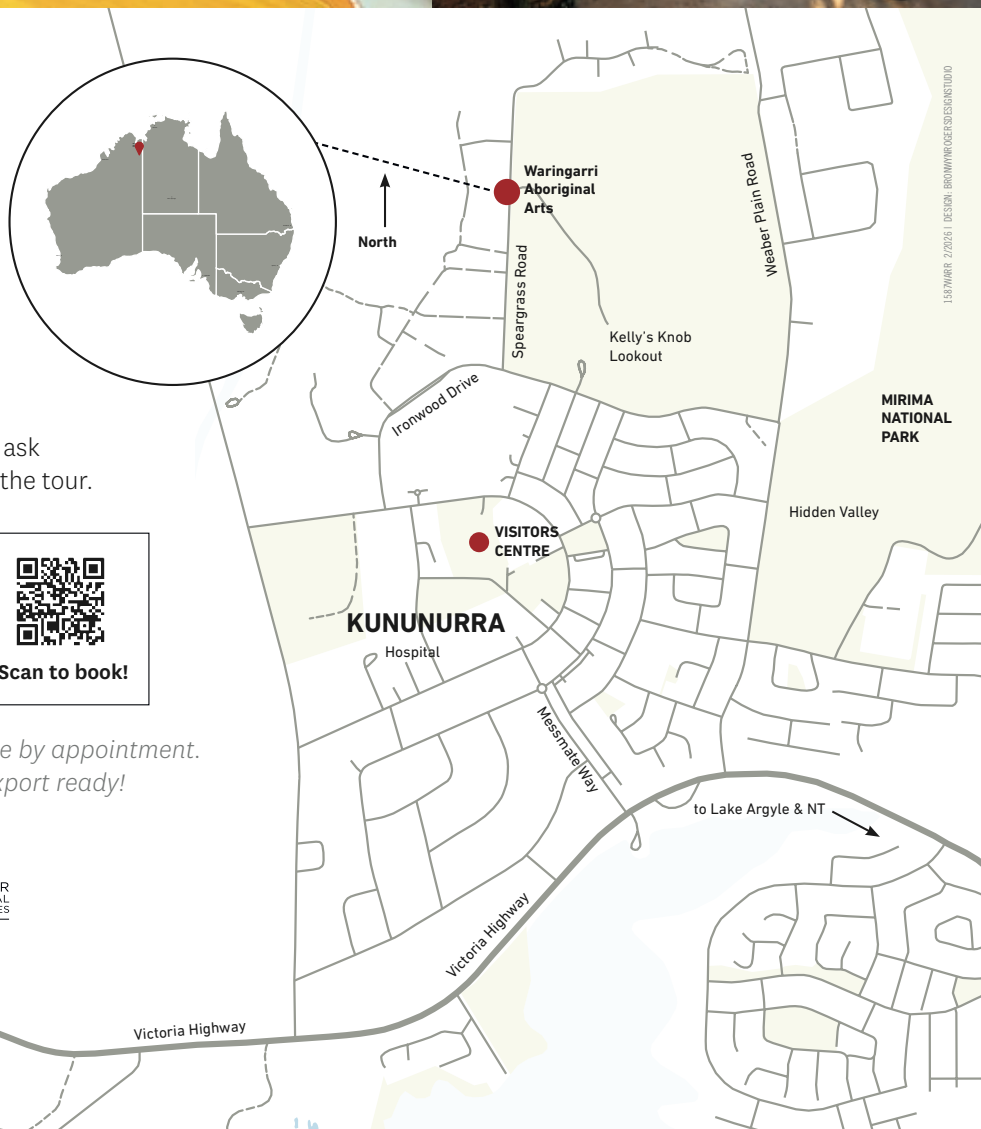
